Nationality: Candidates must be a citizen of India

Academic Requirements

- a) A valid score in CAT or a valid score in Common Management Admission Test(CMAT) conducted by AICTE or a valid score in KMAT.

- b) A pass in any degree examination with 50% marks for candidates belongs to general category, 45% for SEBC, and for SC /ST candidates, a pass in the degree examination will be considered as eligible.

Final Year degree students are also eligible to apply.

- b. All the required details needs to be filled up online along with the supporting documents.
- c. Incomplete applications (not accompanied by documents in proof of claim made) therein will besummarily rejected without further intimation. Documents / certificates furnished aftersubmission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances. Also, noopportunity will be given to incorporate any details or documents after the submissionof the application. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected

80% weightage (approximate) for the valid CAT/KMAT/ CMAT score.

10% weightage (approximate) for Group Discussion and 10% weightage (approximate) for the Personal Interview.
