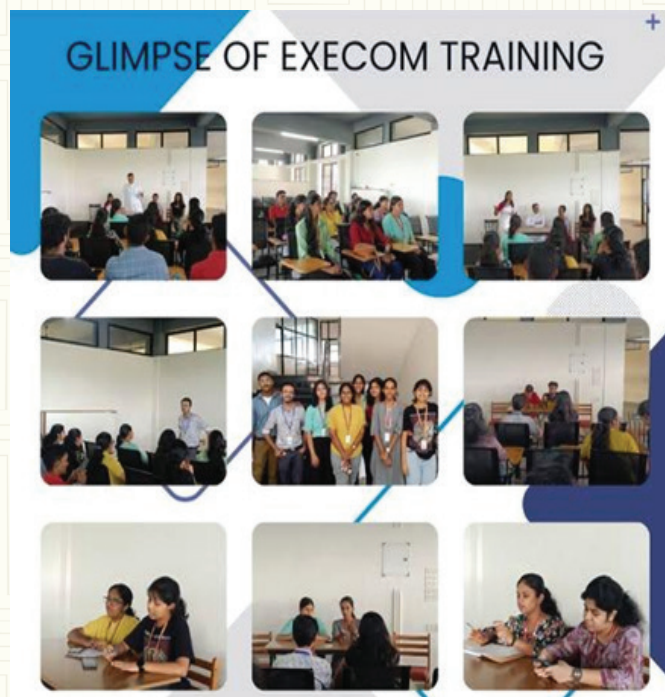
Campus Industrial Park @ LMCST

LMCST Students Participate in IEDC Summit 2025

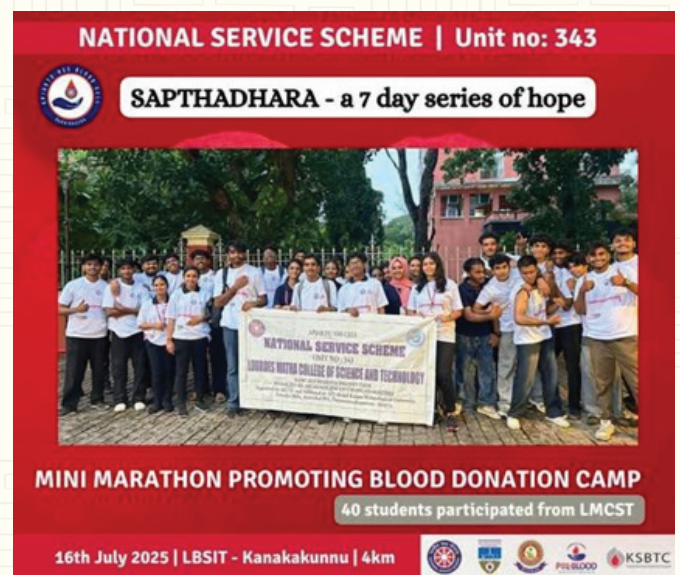

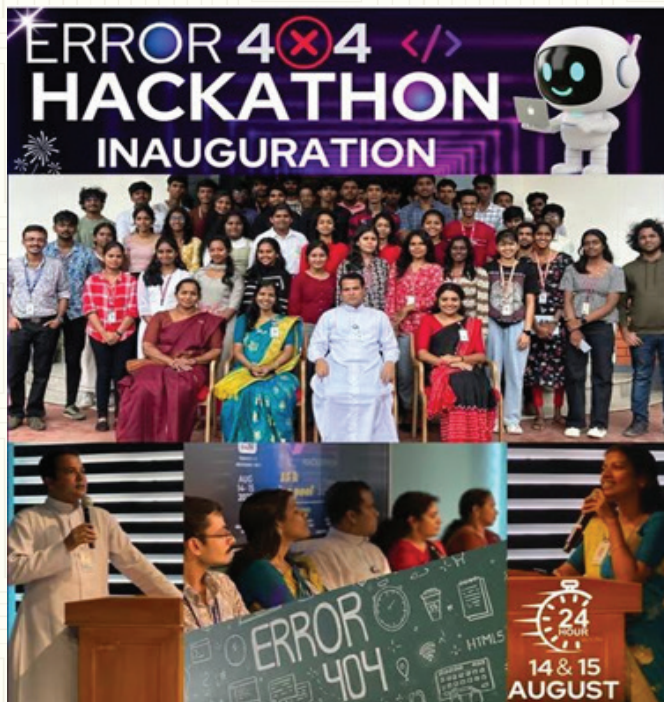
LMCST Students Participate in IEEE Aspire 2025

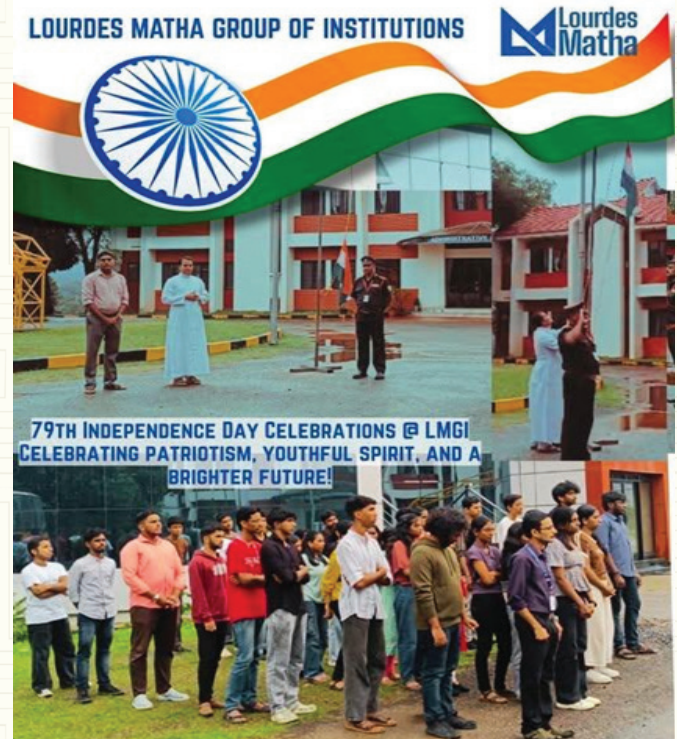
LOURDIAN MUSIC BAND

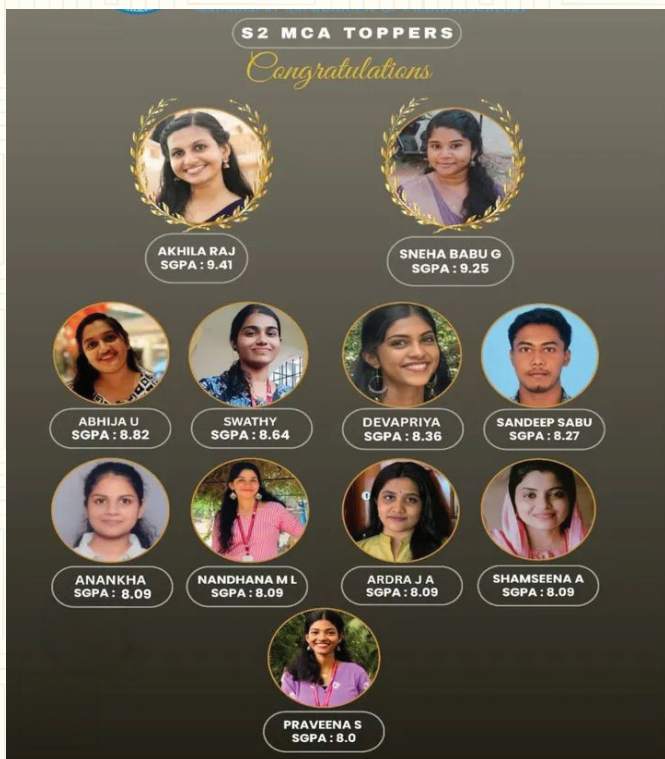

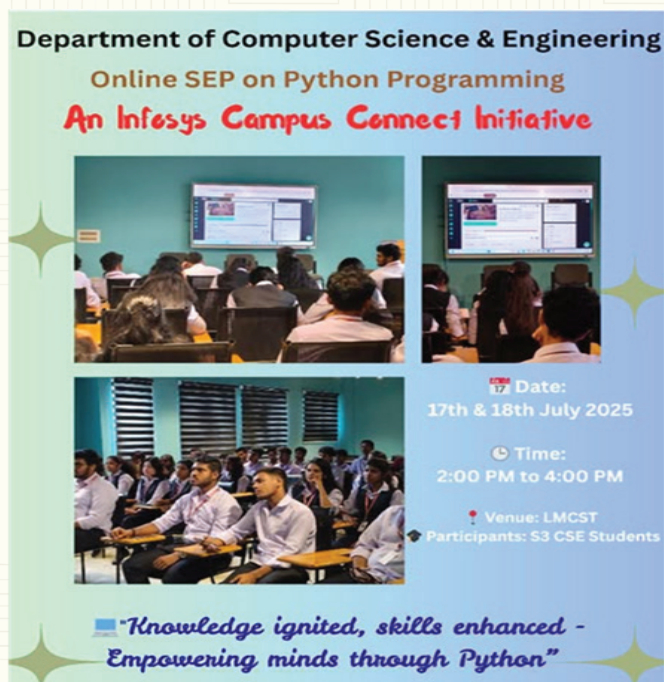

Seminar on “Aryabhata to Gaganyaan”

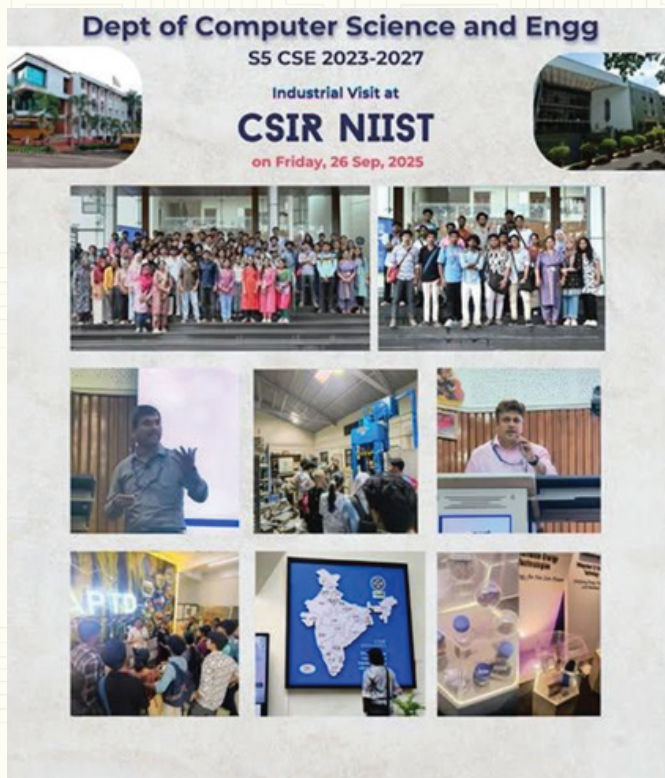

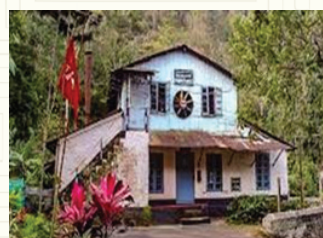
AARAVAM 2K25: Onam Celebrations at LMCST
